Mission and Purpose

As a board member you are individually responsible for:

- Knowing and understanding organisations purpose and mission statement
- Being able to explain what the organisation does and what population it targets
- Being able to provide to people with general information about the NGO's progress and activities



Financial Oversight

As a board member you are individually responsible for :

- Maintaining confidentiality of the boards meetings and financial related issues
- Never excepting/offering bribes or favors with any business associate of the organisation
- Being cautious and careful with any controlling and transferring of funds
- Making sure you understand and are up to date with the organisations financial statements and situation
- Fulfilling your role as a fiduciary



Provide Adequate Resources

As a board member you are individually responsible for:

- Giving an annual contribution based on personal means
- Participating actively in fundraising
- Sharing successful fundraising strategies and fundraising needs
- Using business people and other prominent contacts in the community to provide financial resources to the organisation
- Planning events/lunches to provide financial contacts for the organisation



Communicate with Community

As a board member you are individually responsible for:

- Suggest nominees to the board who are achieved persons you may know from the community
- Convey to the community enthusiasm about the organisation
- Provide publicity for the organisation at events
- Except speaking engagements for the organisation
