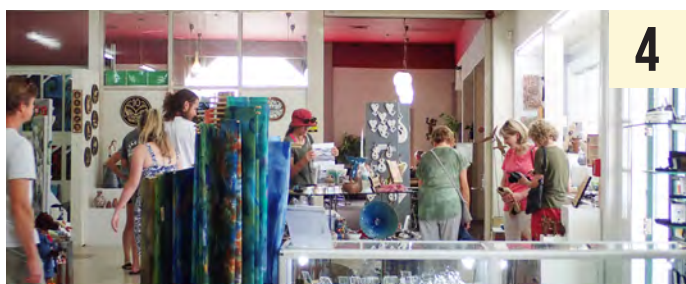


### MEGAN DICKINSON GALLERY

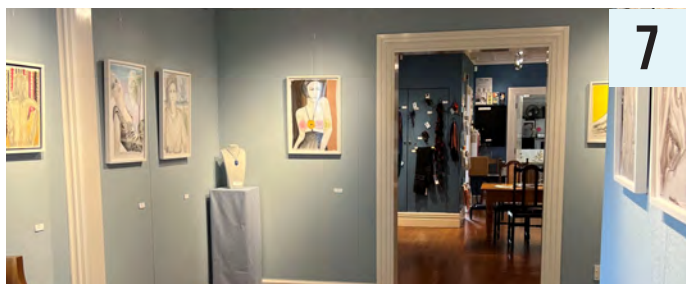


### GRINTER GLASS STUDIO
