### Conditions of entry:

1. All films must be between 5 and 7 minutes long and suitable for family viewing following G certificate guidelines. Entries may be presented in most common digital video file types eg. DVD; USB drive in any common digital video format. Entries will be shown on a large screen so high resolution & wide format look better.
2. Copyright of films remains with the entrant, but the entrant undertakes to grant non-exclusive rights for the partners and cinemas in Northland to screen the film at no cost as part of a Matariki screening package.
3. The judges' decision is final.
4. The competition closes on **31 July 2022**. No late entries will be accepted.
5. Prizes will be awarded on the following criteria:
  - (a) Creativity
  - (b) Narrative
  - (c) Relevance to the Theme of Matariki
  - (d) Technical ability
6. To enter more than one category. Each entry must be a **different** film. All films in all categories are eligible for the Te Ao Maori prize and a separate entry is not required.
7. **It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that any film, images and/or music used are copyright free or used with permission of the owner.**

Entries are to arrive at the Seed, Victoria Street Dargaville or through the on line portal by **5pm 31 July 2022**. Finalists will be notified by **August 19** and their films will be screened at the ANZAC Theatre Dargaville later this year before the prizegiving.
