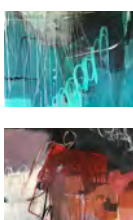


### Phillipa Reeve Creative

Pioneer displays, replicas of local retail shops, and a world-renowned piano accordion collection are all guaranteed to keep visitors engaged for an hour or more.

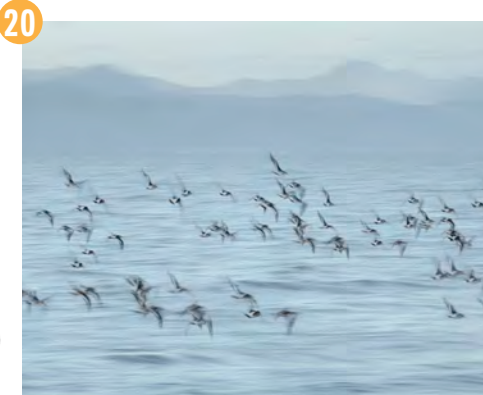
